- Commitment to 1) attend the Friday portion of the Annual Meeting including the Business Meeting/Legislative Update and Trainee Mixer, 2) be available for a photo with the CSP president at the Annual Meeting, and 3) provide a picture & brief statement of how the award was beneficial to you after the meeting for potential posting on the CSP website and social media platforms
